Universal Credit will replace 6 existing benefits (*Income Based JSA, Income Related Employment and Support Allowance, Income Support, Working Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit and Housing Benefit*) with a single monthly payment.

### Does Universal Credit apply to you??

It already applies to working age single people and families in Harrogate who make a new claim **OR** are currently in receipt of a benefit listed above and have a change in their circumstances (e.g. a new baby or separation). If you are in receipt of any of these benefits then you will be transferred to Universal Credit by 2017.

#### How will Universal credit be paid?

If you receive one or more of the benefits above then these payments will be grouped into a single monthly payment made up of a housing cost element and a personal allowance payment. These payments are paid directly to you or your partner. It is your responsibility to pay your rent direct to us. Your claim will be reassessed every month and will be paid by the Department of Works and Pensions. Act Now If you think you may be affected by Universal Credit now or in the future.

#### PLEASE NOTE ONLY EMERGENCY REPAIR CALLS SHOULD BE REPORTED THROUGH TO ASTRALINE.

Any costs of calls made through to the emergency out of hours call centre that are not deemed as an emergency could be recharged back to you.
