Following the Customer Satisfaction Survey last vear results indicated that a number of customers felt less satisfied about the area they live in, Please note that any repairs reported will only a reduction from the results of the last survey carried out in 2016. The 2018 survey indicated that satisfaction in how people felt about the area, particularly in the postcode HG2 which covers Starbeck, had reduced by 11% from the last Make Sure you survey. In order to tackle this Housing Officers, Frances and Ifrah set up a Neighbourhood Strategy meeting to gather information from our customers about the positives and negatives of living in the Starbeck area. Customers identified what they felt were the top 3 priorities that Harrogate Housing Association could help tackle to make the area a better place to live. On the 30 November, 9 customers attended the kick start meeting and it was agreed that the priorities to focus on are :-

hood a better place to live

- 1. Young People—creating opportunities for young people to have somewhere to go and activities to distract them from hanging around streets.
- 2. Tackling the issues in respect of drugs and drug dealing in the area. Working with the Police Community Support Workers to have a joined up approach.
- 3. Environmental Issues such as fly tipping and dog fouling.

The group will meet again in January 2020 to take this forward. Contact the office if you want to get involved.

### Your Rent Increase......

For the past four years the rent you have been charged has reduced each year. This has not affected any planned maintenance or repairs service that Harrogate Housing Association, has carried out in your home. April 2020 will see a return to rent increases based on September's CPI, (Consumer Price Index) which was 1.7% plus 1%. Subject to Board approval your rent will increase by 2.7% in April 2020. If you pay your rent by standing order you must arrange to increase your payments and if you are in receipt of Universal Credit or Housing Benefit you should provide them with a copy of your rent increase as soon as possible to prevent any issues with payments.



## New properties for sale at Kingsley Farm

We have recently acquired 2, 3 bedroomed houses, pictured below, at Kingsley Farm from the developer Stonebridge Homes. The properties are located off Kingsley Road in Harrogate and are up for sale under the shared ownership scheme.

The properties are advertised on the Help to Buy website (helptobuyneyh.co.uk) for £105,000 for a 35% share.

Those interested in purchasing one of these properties will need to have a mortgage offer in place and complete an affordability calculator.

Once this is completed and approved then you would be able to secure the property on payment of a reservation fee of £250.
